SWEENEY FIELD

Sweeney Field, formerly known as Finnesey Field, has been home to 10 different varsity squads at Saint Joseph's University in over 80 years of use. Opened in 1929 as home to the SJU football squad, the field has undergone numerous changes over the years and has been home to over 1,200 SJU varsity games, matches, and track meets. The pitch is the current home of the varsity men's and women's soccer and lacrosse teams.

The field was renamed Sweeney Field in Fall 2013 upon completion of an extensive expansion project. The venue has significantly increased the seating capacity for SJU's varsity lacrosse and soccer programs. The new name recognizes the contributions of Sean S. Sweeney '94 (MBA), a member of the University's Board of Trustees and the lead benefactor to the renovation project. Sweeney Field was blessed in conjunction with Hawktoberfest on October 12, 2013 while a formal dedication was held on April 5, 2014.

The current expansion includes the addition of 1,200 permanent seats to the hillside nearest to the University's iconic Barbelin Hall as well as the addition of 1,100 portable seats on the ends of the field, increasing total seating capacity to 3,000. In addition, the facility includes a new state of the art press box and enhanced sound system while Sweeney Field's turf and track were updated in 2015.

Finnesey Field was named after the late James T. Finnesey. A native of Wyncote, Pa., parishioner at the Gesu and president of a local auto manufacturer, he was a member of the Saint Joseph's Foundation Committee which was established in 1922 to raise support for the College's relocation to Philadelphia's Wynnefield neighborhood. Finnesey was a lead donor to the stadium project in 1927. Legend has it that a 1777 Revolutionary War skirmish took place on the site.

Beginning in 1993, the Saint Joseph's women's lacrosse team has played 216 games on Sweeney Field. Over those 26 seasons, the Hawks have won 43.1 percent of their home games with a record of 93-123. The largest number of consecutive wins on the field stands at five, from February 27 through April 6, 2008 and from March 25 through April 29, 2017, while the most goals scored by SJU on its home field stands at 26, against Mercyhurst on March 4, 1997.

COACH OF THE YEAR



Denise Roessler, 2009

Roessler led SJU to its most successful season in 2009, with the program's first appearance in a championship final. The Hawks fell just short of the A-10 title as they fell to Massachusetts, 15-14, in the championship game, but finished the A-10 regular season with a then-program-best 5-2 record, tying for second place and posting an overall record of 10-8.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR



Bernadette Smith, 2001

Smith recorded 51 goals and 42 draw controls in 2001, matching the conference-best number in the latter category. A two-time All-Conference selection, Smith ranks fourth in career goals (104) and sixth in career points (144) on Hawk Hill.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR



Suzy Herlihy, 2009

Herlihy led the Atlantic 10 in goals against average (8.48) and save percentage (.521) as the Hawks reached the A-10 championship game in 2009. She remains the all-time single-season (10) and career (24) wins leader at SJU and ranks third all-time in GAA and saves, fifth in save percentage (51%), and sixth in ground balls (126).

THE HAWK



One of the most famous mascots in college sports, the Saint Joseph's Hawk has been flapping its wings for more than 60 years. The Hawk, which celebrated its golden anniversary in 2005-06, is best known for staying in constant motion by flapping its wings throughout every basketball game and representing the Saint Joseph's motto, "The Hawk Will Never Die."

Saint Joseph's athletic teams have been recognized with the nickname "Hawks" since 1929. At that time, the school's yearbook editor initiated a contest among the student body for a symbol. More than 100 submissions were narrowed, with "Hawks" winning out over "Grenadiers" by a slim margin. The name was appropriate because it typified "the fighting spirit of our crimson and gray athletes and it is suggestive of the aerial attack which has made our football team famous." Football, ironically, was discontinued at SJU following the 1939 season.

The Hawk mascot has garnered numerous accolades in its over 60-year history. It has been selected as the nation's top mascot by *The Sporting News*, *Sports Illustrated*, *Sports Illustrated for Kids*, *Street & Smith's Basketball Yearbook*, *ESPN College Basketball* magazine and was nominated for the Mascot Hall of Fame in 2008.
